
About the Georgia Gravity Games and Science Street

The Georgia Gravity Games is a gravity-only car race competition sponsored by Google, Georgia Tech and the City of Douglasville. They are an educational, hands-on activity designed to get young people excited about STEM subjects. This exciting event is a way students can take the concepts they learn inside the classroom and apply them in a fun way. What other advanced engineering challenge involves zooming at top speeds through downtown streets?

For the second consecutive year, Science Street will allow competitors and spectators another way to enjoy the Games as they engage with STEM concepts in fun, hands-on ways. Attendees of all ages can visit Science Street, and racers range from elementary school- to high school-aged students. There is no cost associated with being a Science Street exhibitor.

Exhibit Fast Facts

- Science Street will be set up under a high peak white tent and will be provided with one 8-foot table and two chairs.
- Electricity will be available to a select number of exhibitors and must be requested in advance. If your booth will be connected to electricity, please bring your own power strips and extension cords to ensure you have the correct number of outlets close to your exhibit.
- WiFi will be available to all exhibitors.
- Please let Alicin Hendricks know any other needs you have for your exhibit (access to additional space outside the tent, water, etc.) in advance. We will try our best to facilitate any day-of adjustments to suit the needs of your exhibit but cannot guarantee that all requests can be met.

Setup and Breakdown

When arriving to set up your exhibit, all vehicles should approach East Courthouse Square on W Broad Street. Use street parking on W Broad near the intersection with East Courthouse Square to unload supplies. Please bring your own carts/dollies/etc. if you need assistance with your equipment. Once equipment is unloaded, you can proceed west on W Broad Street toward Club Drive and move your car to either of the two parking lots on Club Drive.

A Gravity Games Crew member will be waiting at a table at the back of the Science Street tent to check you in and help you locate your booth. When you check in at the tent, you will also receive your Science Street exhibitor t-shirt.

Breakdown of Science Street exhibits will begin at 2:00 p.m. When you are ready to load out, you can bring your vehicle to the street parking spaces available on W Broad Street.

Streets are subject to change, Science Street team will update exhibitors prior to event.

Day-Of Services

- Snacks will be available throughout the day at the food tent. Several food vendors will be on-site that you can purchase breakfast or lunch from, or feel free to bring your own.
- If you need event assistance, please contact Alicin Hendricks at 706-614-8119. If at any time you have a true emergency, please call 911 or locate Douglasville PD/Fire/EMT onsite. There will be a first aid tent located on the north side of Church Street.
- There will be approximately 500 participants (racers and mentors) and 2,500+ spectators and Science Street attendees, so come prepared for an exciting and busy day!
- Please follow the instructions given to you in this document and by the Gravity Games Crew Members at the event. Crew members are official Gravity Games staffers and will wear Gravity Games t-shirts with "Crew" on the back.
- Please feel free to work out schedules amongst your team to allow each of you to take breaks and check out some of the races - we want you to be able to enjoy the incredible atmosphere! If you check out the races, as a reminder, do not walk onto the racecourse during the race. Spectators may cross the race course at the designated crosswalks, but only when a Crew member deems it safe to do so.
